Readings

First Reading Genesis 17: 1-7, 15-16 God confirms the covenant again with Abram, promising him an enormous number of descendants, to be emphasized by changing his name to Abraham, 'father of a multitude'. God promises to be the Lord of all these succeeding generations. The omitted verses describe how the descendants are to keep the covenant, namely by the practice of circumcision. Abraham's wife is also to change her name, from Sarai (mockery) to Sarah (princess), for she is to have a son (Isaac), although she is 90

Second Reading Romans 4: 13-25

Paul argues that faith in Christ will mean self-denial, obedience and suffering. Becoming a follower means questioning life and asking what it is really about.

Gospel Mark 8: 31-38

Jesus tells the disciples that he will suffer rejection and death at the hands of the authorities, but will rise again. Peter is unhappy either with the idea of such a fate or at such open talk but receives a stinging rebuke from Jesus

3rd Sunday of Lent—4th March First Reading Exodus 20: 1-17

The ten commandments or 'Words' give a summary of the law codes. Israel has only one God. The commandments are phrased in the second person, the person responsible for keeping God's laws is 'you'.

Second Reading I Corinthians 1: 18-25

Paul is preaching the power and wisdom of God as revealed in Christ and the message of the cross.

Gospel John 2: 13-22

The other Gospels place the story of driving the traders from the Temple at the end of Jesus' ministry, but John has it at the beginning. Jesus states that, if the 'temple' were destroyed, he would raise it again in three days.
